

## **Ransomes Jacobsen Ltd Golf Course Environmental Policy Statement**

Ransomes Jacobsen Ltd recognises their duty and has a strong commitment to manage the golf course in a sustainable and environmentally friendly manner. The management committee endorses the adoption of environmentally friendly practices on the course and recognizes the importance of such practices. These practices include waste minimization and recycling, energy efficiency, minimal use of chemicals, water resource management, nature and land conservation.

The committee is committed to ensuring that this policy is communicated to all effected employees or individuals who conduct work on the golf course and other interested parties, and will promote understanding of the policy and the responsibility for its effective implementation.

The business will set and manage progress towards the achievement of detailed objectives that support the top-level objectives stated below:

- Comply with relevant environmental legislation and provide self monitoring to ensure compliance.
- To use planned and systematic processes to understand environmental risks associated with the golf course and to take appropriate action to eliminate or reduce those risks to an acceptable level.
- To establish key environmental measures and to proactively manage improvement in those measures.
- To establish and regularly review the aspects of the golf course that impact on the environment and to continually improve those impacts.
- To run environmental management programmes committed to the conservation of biodiversity and the elimination of pollution.
- To use planned and effective audit processes to provide data on how well the management system is operating and to identify where corrective actions are needed.

This policy will be maintained and reviewed at least annually for continuing suitability.
