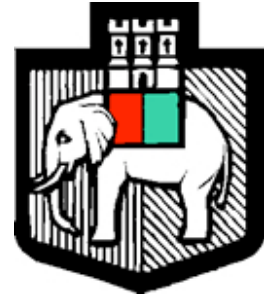


ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

We as members and employees of Coventry Golf Club are proud to announce our commitment to helping safeguard and enhance the natural environment. We recognise that respect for the environment goes hand in hand with human well being and sporting excellence.

In golf, harmonious integration with nature and the wise use of natural resources are the proper goals of all responsible managers. Our policy has four main elements:

- 1) Good housekeeping: to adopt Best Management Practices for the course, club house and ancillary facilities in order to minimise deleterious environmental impacts and to optimise the usage of natural resources.
- 2) Compliance with relevant regulations: to ensure that our activities are in compliance with all relevant local, national and European regulations.
- 3) Conservation of biodiversity and landscape: to maximise the ecological and landscape potential of the golf course.
- 4) Communications and education: to ensure that our environmental attitude, policies and practices are accurately perceived by members, visitors and the public, and to provide appropriate training and information for employees.

It is our goal to achieve continual improvement in environmental performance. We intend to enhance both the ecological value and the recreational enjoyment to be derived from this golf course, and to ensure that our commitment to responsible environmental management is recognised in the wider community. We believe golf can serve as a role model for environmental good practice.
